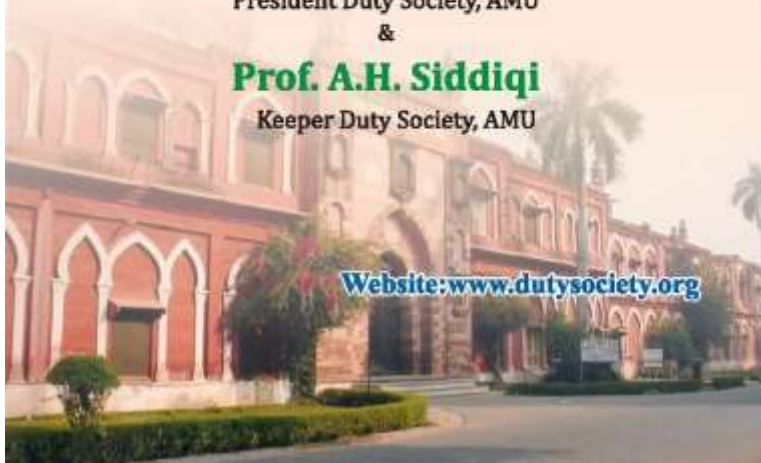

Updated Centenary Volume

The centenary function of the society was organized at Vigyan Bhawan in March 1989. The centenary volume entitled "Aligarh Muslim University Contributions and Achievements" was released on this occasion. It was a modest effort to record contributions and achievements of individuals associated with the AMU over time. The 2014 updated edition of this book will be released by the Hon. Vice President of India on July 29, 2016, at Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi. This work has been completed by a group of dedicated Professors under the guidance of the Editorial Advisory Board chaired by the Vice-Chancellor, Lt General (Retd.) Zameer Uddin Shah.

Seminar Theme

According to Indian constitution, scheduled castes, scheduled tribes and minorities are weaker sections of the nation. Successive governments have paid special attention to their educational advancement. Duty society AMU has focused on the educational development of Muslims as a minority serving other weaker communities as well.

Modern technical education brings prosperity and therefore the seminar will mainly focus on themes related to modern innovative education. The following are suggested themes for the seminar.

- a) A review of existing conditions of modern scientific and technical education among weaker sections in India.
- b) Suggestions for improving scientific and technical education among weaker sections
- c) Impact of government schemes for educational and economic upliftment of weaker sections.
- d) Contribution to science, technology, medical science and mathematics by persons belonging to weaker sections.
- e) Popularization of learning and acquiring knowledge of emerging technologies among weaker sections.
- f) Knowledge based education.
- g) Teaching of mathematics (mother of all sciences and technologies) for weaker sections.
- h) Comparative study of science and technology among different categories of weaker sections.
- i) Education of economically marginalized sections who do not come under the heading of weaker sections.

Distinguished educationists, scientists, engineers and doctors etc. are invited to speak in this seminar. Prof. Sukhadeo Thorat, Chairman ICSSR and former Chairman UGC has accepted our invitation.

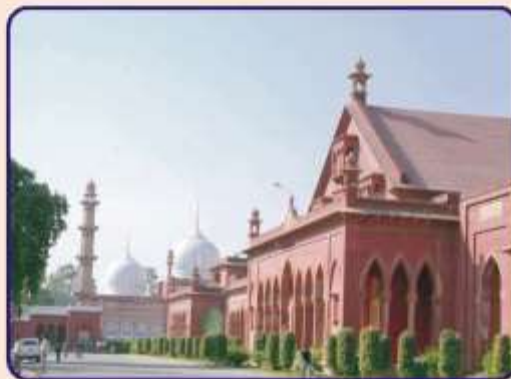
